Accommodation for the tourists isn't such a problem but the hospitality industry is crying out for places to rent or accommodation of some sort for their summer staff.

As we all know, long-term rentals have always been difficult to find in Whanga, normally over summer but it seems to be year-round now.

I wonder what the solution is - do we need more apartment blocks - or a hotel specifically for workers; or purpose built houses with dorms for cheaper accommodation for seasonal workers?

I don't really have the answers - but if anyone, please email us with your thoughts.

I'm reminding myself of that as I write this column on a sunny Coromandel spring Sunday morning the day after the 2020 general election and as I come to terms with the new political landscape that lies ahead of us all.

First, a big 'thank you' to Coromandel voters who have given me the honour of being their face and voice in our Parliament once again. Being the Member of Parliament for Coromandel is something I have never taken for granted and never will. It's a role I take seriously and am passionate about.

Secondly, I'd like to thank the other candidates who put themselves forward for election in Coromandel. Doing so is no small thing. It takes guts, is hard work, and it's demanding in terms of effort, energy and emotion. Our democracy relies on people offering themselves for election so that there is a contest of ideas, policy and debate.

Thirdly, to the hundreds of volunteers from all political

parties who do so much of the ground work in any election campaign. These are the people who back their party and local candidate through thick and thin. Naturally I'm especially grateful to local National Party volunteers and supporters who did such a great job. Thank you.

But for me and my Party the nationwide result was not as we would have wanted. New Zealanders have spoken and I for one completely accept the decision that's been made. Congratulations to the new Government, there is a very big job ahead for you during the next three years.

Results may have been confirmed about the make-up of our Parliament but we're still awaiting results on the two important referendum questions about recreational cannabis use and the End of Life Choice legislation. For reasons that are not clear to me, we're going to have to wait a few more weeks for that.

Thanks again Coromandel. I'm headed back to Wellington this week, humbled by the generous support of local voters and as keen and eager as ever to be a strong voice for our region in Parliament.

# Simpson returned but not too concerned about reduced majority

Coromandel's National MP Scott Simpson said he was confident of being returned to Parliament in the October 17 elections, despite boundaries being changed to his disadvantage.

And his prophecy was correct - although with a much smaller margin over his closest rival, Labour's Nathaniel Blomfield.

In the 2017 elections Scott's majority was 14,326 while this election his majority was 4206.

'Boundary changes meant I lost 9000 voters in the Tatua area and gained just 6000 from the Omokoroa area.

'So I expected the result to be lower than before but was quite confident of being re-elected,' Scott said.

The next three years would be a time to come to terms with the

results of this election, to think and plan toward the future, and to look at what the party needed to do to become strong again, he said.



# Life membership for ardent cyclist

Since 1964, at the age of 13, Steve Bagnall has made cycling a major part of his life – and just recently it has taken a larger meaning than just going out for a quiet ride.

A prostate cancer survivor, Steve has ridden many kilometres raising awareness and funds for the cause.

But his latest milestone is being awarded Life Membership of the Morrinsville Wheelers Cycling Club.

Currently the club's patron, Steve became a member after buying a second hand bike at the age of 13.

'I got hooked on cycling back then when I watched the NZ Road Cycling Champs, which also featured the trials for the Tokyo games, in the area where our family farmed,' Steve said.

He has raced all over New Zealand and when the family moved to Auckland he became a member

of the Manukau Cycling Club. But upon coming to live in Whangamata 20-plus years ago, Steve rejoined the Morrinsville Wheelers.

He admits to being a better track cyclist but his preference is for road racing.



'When you're training on the road there is so much camaraderie, fun and banter and a get together afterward.'

Steve has raced in the former Dulux Cycle Race (now the Wellington to Auckland); has completed the Lake Taupo six times, Titirangi to Tauranga; Auckland to Hamilton; Tour Round the (Hunua) Ranges, and Beachlands to Thames, among others.

All have been between 100km in length or more.

Now in his 70th year, Steve hasn't given consideration to retiring – so keep an eye out for him on the road!

The blood service's Waikato Coordinator Chris Dickinson said the recent visit

attracted similar numbers to the blood drive in April.

'In April this year 61 attended and 57 units of whole blood was collected, while this month we had 58 donors and 55 units collected,' Chris said.

'The need for blood is constant, so the more donors we can see at our visits is only going to help the cause.'

# Whangamata Ratepayers' Association needs YOU to speak out

The annual general meeting for the association attracted 160 interested people, keen to express their concerns about roading, boardwalks, mangroves, reserve management plans and other topics.

But when it came to seeking nominations for the committee, heads went down and no eye-contact was made with those sitting up front - in other words, the existing committee.

Graeme Manson and Brian Airey are heading the committee with the assistance of long-term member Suzie Smith.

Suzie and Brian and other committee members expressed their desire at the AGM to stand down but agreed to stay on when no one put up their hand for committee.

'We need the backing of the community to act as watchdog over local issues between TCDC and/or WRC and our ratepayers,' Brian said.

Graeme Manson said being on the committee was not an onerous job.

'We need people with the knowledge to read, understand and reply to council reports. Some require specialist knowledge and we know there are many retired people here, or who own homes, who have specialist knowledge on a wide range of topics,' Graeme said.

'We also need younger people who can have a say on reports or what they think the town needs.'

More members to support or join the executive committee would be welcome - and at just \$10 for an annual subscription, that won't break the bank, Brian said.

'There's a certain amount of work to do and it would be good to share the workload. We need members who can help us ensure we hold the council to accountability.'

Issues such as kerb and channelling, rates, roading programmes (such as Wentworth Valley Rd) need to be kept in the public eye, especially when something goes wrong, Graeme said.

'For instance, there was a muck-up with the kerbing in Kiwi Rd and part of it had to be dug up and redone. Who's paying for that? Ratepayers? The company doing the work?'

'Openness and honesty is what we require from our council and we need voices in our group to add their voices and speak out about their concerns.'

He was also concerned about the amount of rates paid by Whangamata property owners and the amount spent back in the community.

'The amount of return we get is minute compared to the millions of dollars our ratepayers pay,' Graeme said.

## Stock up on water ahead of a potentially dry summer

In our District we use an average of 13 million litres of water per day.

In summer this can rise to 25 million litres per day – that's enough to fill 10 Olympic-sized swimming pools.

The rain we're having this spring is a good reminder to start thinking about collecting rainwater ahead of another potentially long, dry summer. So why not look at installing a water tank on your property for outside use? It's perfect for cleaning the car and boat or keeping the flowers, vegetables and lawns alive.

The process is simple:

- Find a spot on your property where you would like to place a tank.
- Talk to a tank manufacturing company about colour, size, cost and delivery.
- Discuss your plans and get the right advice on whether you need a building or resource consent. A building consent is not required if the tank meets the requirements for capacity and height-above-ground. For example, the Building Act allows tanks that hold no more than 35,000 litres, and which are not plumbed into a house for drinking water supply, to be installed without a building consent as long



as they are supported directly by the ground and sit more than 1.5 metres from the property boundary.


## DOG RULES







Whiritoa - 12km south of Whangamata. Swim or walk, collect shells.

Whangamata Harbour, Ocean Beach and Otahu Estuary - check these areas for yourself. The various spots are ideal for SUP, kayaking, surfing, swimming, diving, spearfishing, snorkelling, jetskiing and skiing.

Onemana - swimming is OK along the beach. The south end is safest for children. A good beach for surfcasting. Mussels and kina in the area around the rocks.

Opoutere - All the above activities. Access through the pine forest. Bird watching is an added attraction here.

Note: At all beaches, watch for rips and do not swim out beyond your comfort zone.

Many attractions on the valley walks, including waterfalls and swimming holes. Grab a brochure from info-Plus Visitor Centre in Port Rd.

Numerous adjuncts and clubs, from athletics to yoga, meet regularly in Whangamata so check with info-Plus if there's anything specific you're interested in.





## Saving our Planet #11: Living with a better purpose

# Be artistic, tasteful and practical when it comes to gardening!

It's time to green up, and we're not talking about cannabis law reform (which way did you vote?!)

Ever noticed how our town is looking a bit sterile, maybe even overly manicured? Your garden doesn't need to look like a dry riverbed. River stones belong in the river! As for those bloody yucca! Gardens should be alive and uplifting - places you want to tend. Here are some ideas.

The sport that has caught on all around the world isn't new to New Zealand.

'Some of the staff have been




