The success of the Festival is in large part due to the commitment and dedication of our volunteer crew who give up their time to help make the event run so smoothly.



Police report

Hello all,

With Beach Hop rapidly approaching, Police would like to remind people of the special requirements of the event so we can all have an enjoyable, safe time. Here is some information relating to alcohol and vehicle offences

Thames Coromandel District Council have set temporary alcohol bans in all public places in Whangamatā from 4pm on Tuesday, 22 November until 4am on Monday, 2 November.

This is a 24/7 ban which means you may not possess, carry or consume alcohol in public places or vehicles in a public place. The legislation relating to the liquor ban authorises police to search containers or vehicles without a warrant. The only exemption to this is self-contained camper vans, provided alcohol is only consumed within the vehicle, it is parked in a designated freedom camping area, and the number of people inside the vehicle does not exceed the maximum number allowed on the vehicle's self-containment certificate.

Police have discretion around enforcing the by-law exemptions, but as a rule of thumb if you remove alcohol from the ban area within an hour from the time you buy it then this is prompt. If you are bringing alcohol into the ban area to go to a licensed premise or a friend's place,



then prompt travel through the ban area would be going directly to your destination. Breaching this bylaw could result in a \$250 ticket or in some cases arrest. If you require further information please visit tcdc.govt.nz.

Anti-social driving activities such as burnouts, and unnecessary displays of speed or acceleration will likely result in the car being impounded at the owner's expense for 28 days and an appearance before the court. If you're convicted, you could be jailed for up to three months or fined up to \$4,500. You'll also be automatically disqualified for at least six months so please be mindful of this. A further reminder that the police will be out in force testing for drunk/drugged drivers and that the legal breath and blood limits for under 20s is zero.

Looking at the number of great events within the Beach Hop umbrella I'm sure there will be something for everyone, and it'll be a great event yet again.

Enjoy and stay safe out there.

The National Scholastic Surfing Championship team which comprised 12 surfers was made up of 10 surfers from the Whangamata Surf Academy, which continues to produce some great results with our young surfers from the community. They placed fourth overall from 12 regional teams. This is the best they have done for over a decade.

The event was held at Taranaki from 10-14 October.

India Kennings also won the Adam Clegg Award for Breakthrough Female Surfer (peer judged).

Auckland Claims Maiden National Scholastic Surfing Championships

The Auckland Junior Surfing Team has claimed their maiden National Scholastic Surfing Championship at Back Beach, Taranaki on 14 October. Until today, the surf-proud region has not been able to put their name on the trophy since the event's inception in 1989.

The team won the title by the smallest of margins, staking claim to three of the eight individual titles on offer, to outpoint defending champions Canterbury in second place and Bay of Plenty in third.

Individual titles were shared around the regions with Canterbury winning two and Otago, Coromandel and Gisborne all picking up one a piece.

The final day of the event was held in clean waves of up to 1.0m at Back Beach, south of New Plymouth. Offshore winds prevailed all morning, with an incoming tide making the action close to the vociferous cheering teams beachside.

Auckland's three titles went to Liv Haysom in the Under 18 Girls Division, Leia Millar in the Under 16 Girls Division and Nat Fitt in the Under 18 Boys Longboard Division. Year in, year out, it has proven that the teams that can win the titles on the final day jump up the overall rankings.

Coromandel's title went to India Kennings (WGM) who won her first ever national event in the Under 14 Girls Division.

Coromandel jumped up the overall rankings to fourth place thanks to five finals berths today.

Gisborne's title went to Jay Emere-Ryan in the Under 18 Girls Longboard Division.

Otago's title went to Alexis Owen who put on a dominant display in the Under 14 Boys Division.

Final team standings at the 2022 National Scholastic Surfing Championships held at Taranaki from the 10-14 October:

- 1st** Auckland - 8090
- 2nd** Canterbury - 8008
- 3rd** Bay of Plenty - 7845
- 4th** Coromandel - 7453

The National Scholastic Surfing Championships has been held since 1989. The event, which has unearthed two generations of top Kiwi talent, takes place along the Taranaki coastline.

The event comprises eight age group divisions for males and females across both shortboard and longboard disciplines. Twelve regional teams from throughout the country contest the event with eleven teams in attendance in 2022 vying for both individual titles as well as the overall team title. Canterbury is the defending champion at the event having won the event in home waters in 2020.

Over 110 surfers are participating at the event in 2022 after having qualified to represent their 12-person teams via a series of regional events held during winter months.

The Armistice, to stand (still) arms

The Armistice, an agreement to end the fighting of the First World War as a prelude to peace negotiations, began at 11am on 11 November, 1918.

The Whangamata RSA held remembrance on 11 November at 11am with a bagpiper to welcome guests and with a bugler, symbolising the sending of signals and orders by soldiers.

Geoff March presented an insight before the Ode Reveille and the numbers he gave are truly staggering. "As we commemorate 104 years since the end of WWI it is known that 16,697 New Zealanders were killed and 41,317 were wounded



during the war - a 58 percent casualty rate."

Approximately a further thousand men died within five years of the war's end, as a result of injuries sustained, and 507 died while training in NZ between 1914 and 1918. Geoff says "recovery took many years".

It was the war to end all wars, unfortunately as we know history has proven this wrong, New Zealanders are still involved in many areas of conflict in support roles

as well as training and rebuilding infrastructure.

"ANZAC was formed in WWI, as well as the forming of RNZ RSA, we have both come a long way, the basics of both are still the core reason for both to exist".

The armistice initially expired after a period of 36 days and had to be extended several times. A formal peace treaty was only reached when the Treaty of Versailles was signed the following year.



Ian Johansen from Wentworth Valley has bought himself a 143-year-old, five tonne steam boat. He found the adorable Alice on the hardstand at the Sulphur Point Marina in Tauranga recently.

She had been there for three months and was originally from Taupō where she offered lake trips and before that she was on the Kaipara Harbour for 30 years.

Alice was not for sale when Ian found her, but while wandering around the yard he spotted her and thought "this is a bit of me!". She needs about \$40k of work and some wooden timber replaced and it will be a journey of love for sure.

It's believed Alice was a New

Zealand-built wooden steam-powered vessel constructed in the late 1800s, at the tail end of the first industrial revolution.

Ian's plans for Alice are a work in progress, she will be in his large shed for a couple of years for restoring, repairing and re-corking of the planks. She'll then get back in survey and finally in the Whangamatā harbour for a few years for all to enjoy.

She will run on slow-burning manuka and will be a destination call for enthusiasts of the era of steam - what an asset for Whangamatā!


the driver back it into the tight corner of Ian's shed - he could have parked it on a dime!

Be wary – counterfeit notes are in town

Recently, a counterfeit note was shown to the RSA by a customer who said that \$10 and \$20 notes have also been found!

It's actually quite obviously different to a real note, with a funny plastic feel, no silver in the clear window as a real note would have, it's a little smaller

but deceptively so, the colour is a close match.



Unique Wonder Tournament held at RSA

Over 88 players attended the Unique Wonder Tournament which is in memory of Gay Laurenson and is hosted and played annually by the Whangamata RSA Mahjong Group at the Whangamata RSA.

The tournament is named after Gay Laurenson's favourite hand and was held last Sunday.

When entering the RSA the loud sounds of tiles were overwhelming and actually very soothing, the sound of tiles during the shuffling is meant to resemble the chattering of sparrows.

Interestingly, Mahjong is a tile-based game that was developed in the 19th century in China and has spread throughout the world since the early 20th century. It is commonly played by four players (with some three-player variations found in parts of China, Japan, South Korea and Southeast Asia). The game and its regional variants are widely played throughout East and Southeast Asia and have also become popular in Western countries. The game has also been adapted into a widespread online entertainment. [Similar to the Western card game rummy, Mahjong is a game of skill, strategy, and luck. To distinguish it from mahjong solitaire, it is sometimes referred to as mahjong rummy.

The game is played with a set of 144 tiles based on Chinese characters and symbols, although many regional variations may omit some tiles or add unique ones. In most variations, each player begins by receiving 13 tiles. In turn, players draw and discard tiles until they complete a legal hand using the 14th drawn tile to form four melds (or sets) and a pair (eye). A player can also win with a small class of special hands. While many variations of mahjong exist, most variations

have some basic rules in common including how a piece is drawn and discarded, how a piece is robbed from another player, the use of suits (numbered tiles) and honors (winds and dragons), the basic kinds of melds allowed, how to deal the tiles and the order of play.

Although the chattering of tiles




Whangamatā RSA President gives insight to history

2013: Whangamatā was allocated the battle of Le Quesnoy to commemorate, this was a Coromandel wide project developed by then Mayor Glenn Leach, so Whangamata RSA, Lions Club and TCDC got together and agreed to find some land and create a concept of how we would commemorate such a momentous battle.

We found land opposite Moana House entrance, sourced native trees and held many working bees with the Community to turn the land into a usable area. We decided on a koru shaped forest that was the Kiwi touch.

2015: after the ANZAC Day Beach Service the community was invited to the now planted forest for the official opening, at that point the

weather turned against us and there was heavy rain (some say it added to the occasion). We had two returned servicemen who were guests of honour to officially open the forest, we had relatives and family representatives who gave speeches.

Those who attended then went back to Whangamata RSA to continue ANZAC DAY proceedings.

2017: In February, a delegation from the Association Le Quesnoy Nouvelle-Zélande had the opportunity to visit our forest, they were visiting their sister city Cambridge and were touring the Coromandel, they were supposed to only visit for 30 minutes, in fact they ended up staying for 90 minutes, and had tears as they left.

During their visit they put out an invitation to attend their town's commemorations on 4 November this year.

Refurbishment of signs holds great meaning

2022: It was decided to refurbish the three signs as seven years had taken its toll on the condition of the signs.

Whangamatā Menzshed refurbished the signs and, on 4 November, a crowd of around 40 held a commemoration of the battle and the unveiling of the signs.

Kiwi Christmas Books began as a personal project for TV reporter and author Sonya Wilson in 2019. It quickly scaled with over 6,600 new books gifted to families in need or in crisis last year, and 22 different charities used to distribute books to families doing it tough.

Sarah Halliday, Manager of Eastern Coromandel Community Services Trust said the charity is happy to be involved.

"Many in Whangamatā will already know about our Foodbank service and actively support it, but many will be unaware of our Christmas gift service for children who would otherwise go without. We are grateful to Adelle and the team at Page Break who initiated the relationship with Kiwi Christmas Books. We know it will make a

meaningful difference to those in need this Christmas', she said.

Sonya Wilson from the national charity said she is delighted to now have a bookstore and charity for distribution in Whangamatā

'Reading is hugely beneficial to young people. In books kids can travel into other worlds, into other heads, into experiences that might otherwise be out of their reach. I really hope that locals will jump on board and buy books for kids in need, as well as for their own children, this Christmas. Books are a taonga, enriching the lives of children who may otherwise go without.'

New children's books can be purchased or dropped off at Page Break/NZ Post at 610a Port Road.



The books will be given to the Community Services Trust at the end of the collection campaign on 12 December.



The new Lions Whangamatā Information Booklet 2022/23 is out.


This year sees the 45th Edition of the booklet, increased to 92-pages in a bigger A4 size.
